Costs are based on completion of 36 total credits. Some programs and courses may have additional costs.

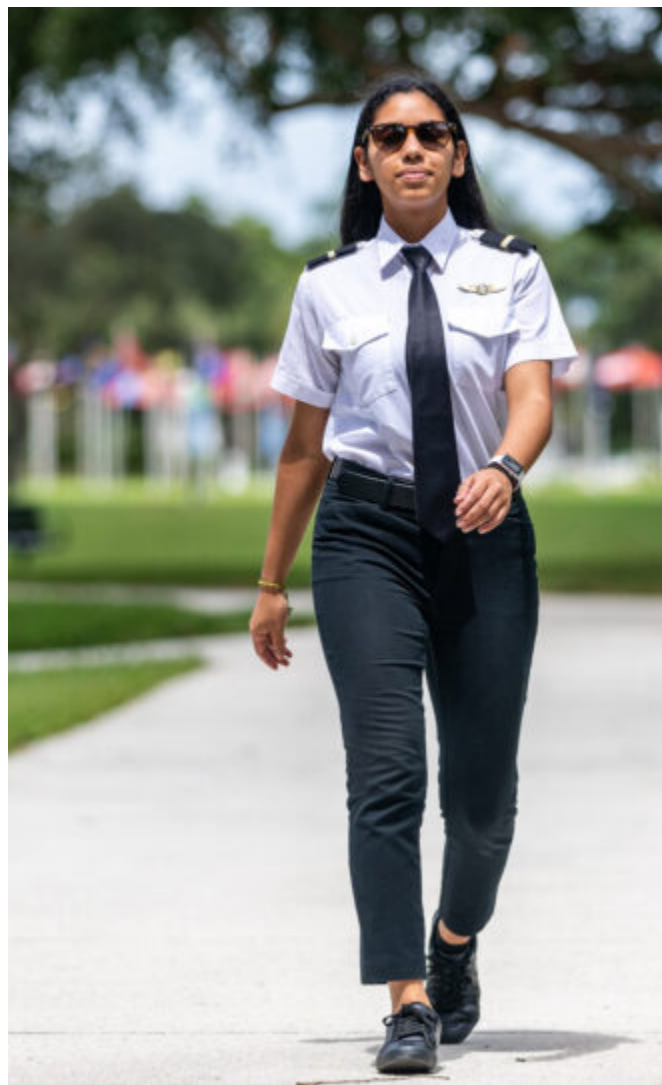
Master's in psychology, criminal justice, educational leadership, exceptional student education, public administration and clinical mental health counseling are \$650 per credit in 2023–2024.
